



2023 Impact


- Population Served: Youth ages 10-24 years old from Kent, Ottawa, Ionia, Montcalm Counties
- ▶ **800** youth
- ▶ 18,552 services provided: case management, therapy, assessments, intakes, groups, social rec activities, service learning, shelter nights, crisis calls, and aftercare
- ▶ **26** Community Education Presentations


Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP)


- \$1.2 million awarded annually to Kent County for Youth Housing
- ► Arbor Circle awarded \$626,700
- ► Host Homes for 10 youth- \$150,000
- Rapid Rehousing for 22 youth- \$296,700
- Outreach to 75 youth- \$180,000
